

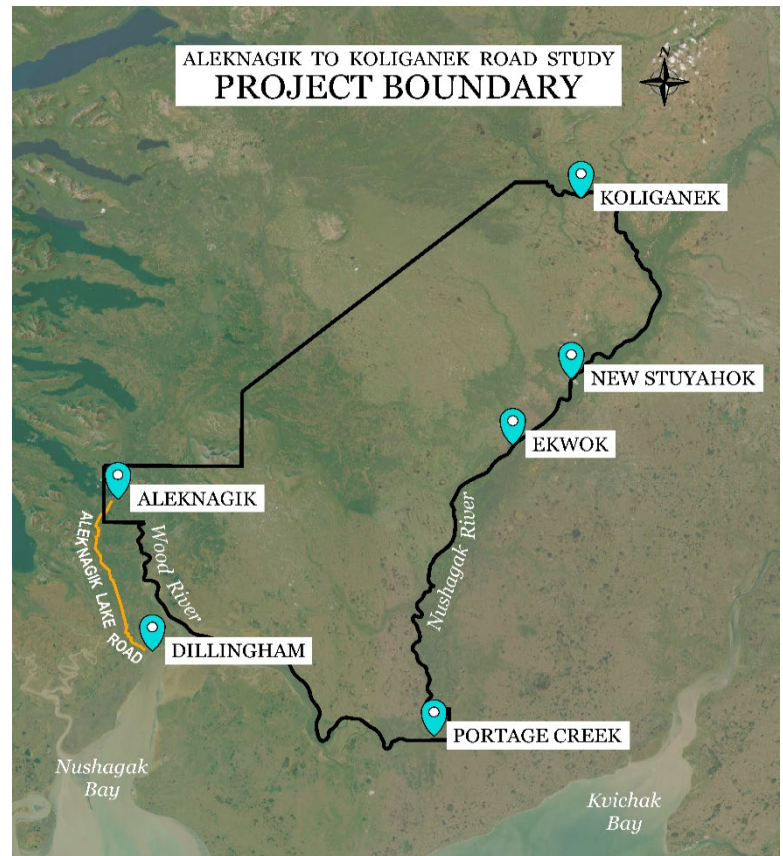
Aleknagik to Koliganek Road Feasibility Study

We are excited to announce the launch of the Aleknagik to Koliganek Road Feasibility Study, an early-stage project to evaluate the potential for developing a road connection between the communities of Aleknagik, Portage Creek, Ekwok, New Stuyahok, and Koliganek.

This study will evaluate possible routes for new roads between the communities, collect feedback from stakeholders on potential social and cultural impacts, and understand the possible economic benefits. This study does not propose the construction of a road system but instead focuses on determining if communities desire a road connection and if a future road project is feasible.
